Description	All throughout southern France, southern Germany and northern Italy, small producers make farmhouse-style gentian liqueurs. Historically consumed on the rocks or with a splash of soda water.

Notes	<p>In France, Pernod Ricard makes Suze, a gentian liqueur. Unfortunately, over the past few years, it's been reformulated to make it more accessible to the "vodka soda set" - making it sweeter and less bitter.</p> <p>Gentian was the original bitter herb used in Continental Europe for liqueurs - cinchona (quinine) wasn't available until after the discovery of America.</p>
